- How do we reconcile God's slow work with the possibility of God's shaking the world?
- In what way does the Exodus narrative parallel the African American experience in the United States? What are the advantages of comparing the two stories? What are the disadvantages?
- Who do you view as a historical Moses figure? As a contemporary Moses figure? How do we recognize contemporary Moses figures when they appear?
- What does it mean to us, individually and collectively, that God takes sides in the world? How have you experienced this partisan God in your own life? In the life of the Church? In the life of the world?
- How does the Exodus story reveal the overarching redemptive work of God in the Bible?
